London Gateway will be the UK's first 21st Century major deep-sea container port and one of Europe's largest logistics parks offering over 9million square feet of logistics space. Situated on the north bank of the River Thames in Thurrock, Essex, the £1.5 billion development will provide the UK with a new world class infrastructure asset and a brand new gateway to global trade.

London Gateway's deep sea port will be the most fully automated and efficient in the country, adding an additional 3.5million TEU (standard twenty foot equivalent cargo units containers) to the nation's port capacity. The port will become a national trading hub for the UK and will accommodate the world's largest container ships, which have substantially increased in size over the past decade.

In addition to a major deep sea port, London Gateway will provide one of Europe's largest logistics parks, which will offer individual distribution centres in excess of one million square feet.

About the Role

This position reports to the Director of Civil Engineering and the main purpose of the role is to deliver a large and complex upgraded branch line & rail terminals, to interface with a major business park development; to interface with a port access bridge and associated road works; to deliver numerous minor infrastructure works; Responsible for the technical management of the project, combining design work with project management.

The key objectives of the role will include:-

- Ensure that the rail terminal is built to a standard suitable for the planned rail operation of the port and business park;
- Ensure that all of the requirements of Network Rail are met;
- Ensure that all of the above works are completed on time and budget to the requirements of DP World;

Key responsibilities will be to:

- Plan and organise delivery of the rail programme ensuring that it will be delivered on time and within budget;
- Appoint the appropriate contractors for the works;
- Drive the rail infrastructure to ensure that the needs of the customer will be met as well as the requirements of the LG project programme;
- Complete the tender process for the railway works;
- Manage works carried out by Consultants and Contractors to ensure that that the objectives are achieved;
- Work with other team members to ensure all rail related interfaces are managed and be responsible for managing these interfaces with Network Rail;
- Ensure that all contractor non-conformance/complaints are resolved efficiently and effectively, with relevant improvements made as necessary;
- Liaise and work with relevant authorities to ensure timely approvals for LG works are obtained. These duties will include detailed technical discussions with Network Rail, Local Highways and Planning Authorities and the Environment Agency. DP World will provide specialist advice on legal and planning matters;
